Dallas grass - going to be applying 3rd application next week to treat Dallas Grass on treetops and green surrounds, this will take a couple of years to really gain control on the infestation, we will be focusing on fairways next year in addition to the Tees and green surrounds.

- **New Equipment!** expecting to receive new equipment soon which will make the appearance and playability much better and make for a healthier turf stand.
- Tree work we will continue on trimming and limbing up trees this fall through spring in areas of play that will improve ball lie and playability.
- Tee Markers planning on replacing tee markers with new updated more appealing markers this winter.
- •Bunkers will be planning renovation on select bunkers for new sand and drainage.
- Par 3 Tee Boxes over seeding select par 3s this fall with rye grass for a better turf stand and recovery through cold months.
- Landscape areas planning to bark monuments landscape areas and deer grass beds this winter
- Restrooms looking into upgrading toilet paper holders and locking mechanisms for restroom doors.
- Bridges we will be fixing areas that need attention on bridges for repair this winter.
